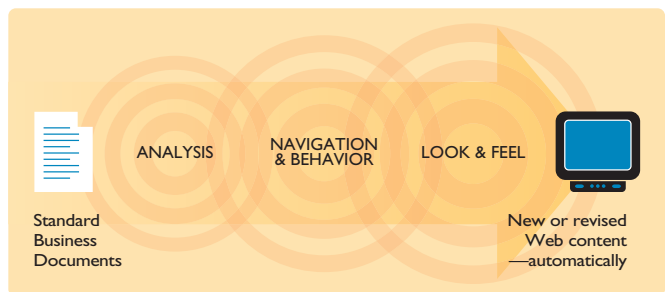

- Saves time and money by automating the creation and maintenance of website content using files that already exist.

- Converts and publishes content from virtually any file type, such as documents, spreadsheets, presentations, images and even publishes rich media.
- Gives users direct access to source documents while previewing staged content in an Internet browser.
- Reliably and accurately maintains large and complex link sets, such as within online catalogs, technical and legal documentation.
- Eliminates manual link maintenance by maintaining the link structure of files and automatically updates links whenever users revise content.

## HOW IT WORKS



*Starting with standard business documents you work with everyday, Transit Solutions analyzes the document structure and then converts this information to Web content that reflects the navigation, behavior and consistent look and feel you designate.*

- Automatically creates web page indexes, tables of contents, and lists of figures based on the structure of the original document for sophisticated navigation capabilities.
- Ensures that web content is up-to-date by monitoring source documents and republishing entire folders on a pre-set schedule.
- Reduces website updating time by up to 90 percent by eliminating manual coding efforts that burden Webmasters.
- Allows content contributors to create and edit content without knowing HTML or learning new software; simply save existing files to a designated folder on the network
- Easily integrates with web content management and website design applications.
- Uses customizable web templates to ensure consistent formatting regardless of the type of source file used.
- Enables website redesign at any time by employing centrally controlled templates.

### FEATURES AND HIGHLIGHTS

#### Enhanced Edit Template window

Provides the command center for controlling how and where content from source documents is published. Combines preview, publication hierarchy and properties into one window, and makes it easy to access and change commonly used features to edit templates.

**Expanded input support** Imports and converts content from over 250 file formats, including files created using the Microsoft Office 2007 suite—presentation, spreadsheet, documents, images, and others.

**Edit Source option** Enables users to directly access source documents for editing while previewing staged content that has been published from Transit.

**Rich media plug-in** Allows users to place rich media directly into Microsoft Word 2007 or 2003 source documents, then automatically convert and publish the documents.

**Abstraction** Automatically analyzes the structure of inbound documents as the basis for Transit Templates, which results in consistent output formatting.

**Transit templates** Allows users to pair documents with Transit templates for complete control over web page layout, fonts, colors, scripts, and navigation.

**XML capabilities** An XML Map file enables site navigation, page printing and conditional access to information. XML-encoded conversion templates give users the flexibility to make changes using XML authoring tools. Transit also accepts XML inputs and can convert standard business documents into XML.

**Metadata** Transit can convert document summary information into HTML metadata that users can promote to web page indexes, tables of contents or other pages for reference and navigation purposes.

**Scheduled updates** Use Transit Central to create a schedule for automatic website content updates.

**Enhanced layout design** Deploy templates for tables or framesets based on imported custom table layouts created in any HTML editor or design application. Cascading style sheets provide greater layout and design control of line spacing, fonts, margins, borders, etc.
